

- Please turn at our Entrance 3 (Bristol Dragway Main Entrance), from Highway 394, you will make an immediate right turn. Medallion Campground will be your first campground on the left.
- Once the campground is open you may check-in 24 hours a day.
- Once you arrive at Medallion's check-in booth please give us the name you used to make your reservation and we'll check you into the campground and issue the permit(s) for your campsite(s).

Overlooking the Speedway grounds and the Bristol Dragway entrance is a new benchmark of camping luxury featuring a private, exclusive "gated community" of 20' x 50' numbered reserved spaces with power, water and sewer hook-ups.

The entire camping area is paved and landscaped and offers special amenities including WiFi, private golf cart shuttle service, a free gift from one of our sponsors, and 24-hour assistance & security.

No Open Fires – Must be off the ground and in something you can put a lid on.

- Gold, Silver & Bronze campers will enter at Entrance 1 Hwy 11-E of Bristol Motor Speedway and follow the directional signage to the check-in booth.
- Once the campground is open you may check-in 24 hours a day.

CAMPGROUND PASSES

On arrival to your campground check-in booth you'll receive one RV pass and one Vehicle pass per campsite. All camping and vehicle passes must be applied on the driver side windshield and passenger side of the camper and remain visible for the duration of the event.

Printed on the permits you will find the designated section and site number that is reserved for you and we will be happy to help you find your site upon arrival.

Ticket Information

Each person entering the camping area MUST have a ticket for each event day remaining. The tickets must be presented upon each and every entrance to the camping area, no exceptions. You are encouraged to purchase tickets ahead of time to avoid delay in parking and you can do so by calling our ticket office at 423-BRISTOL or Toll Free at 866-415-4158.

ADDITIONAL VEHICLES

If your vehicle does not fit into your space or if you have additional vehicles to park, please see our staff at your check-in booth for more information about additional parking. No vehicles may be parked in an adjacent site or suite parking area. Violation of this policy will result in towing at owner's expense.

All parking on BMS property is now paid permit parking. This also includes our camping extra vehicle parking. Extra vehicle passes are \$25 and can be purchased by the account holder in advance by calling the ticket office at 423-989-6900. The account holder may also purchase an extra vehicle pass at the check-in booth, but will need to have exact change. Once the extra vehicle parking permit has been issued that vehicle will need to be parked in our Bronze section of the campground on the very back row. There will be signs present to designate this area. An additional parking area is also available for Medallion Campers, and is located in the gravel lot of the campground.

VIOLATION OF POLICIES WILL RESULT IN TOWING AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS



- Please visit or call your check-in booth for any camping questions, or to report any noise complaints or security concerns.
 - *See important numbers section for check-in booth phone numbers. (Dial 911 for Emergencies).
- Quiet hours are enforced between midnight—7AM. Please be responsible during posted quiet hours and respect your neighbors.
- No open fires (must be off the ground and in something you can put a lid on, ex—fire pit, barrel, etc.) BBQ grills & propane grills are permitted. Propane fill is not available on BMS property.
- Personal golf carts, ATVs, etc. are prohibited. Licensed street motorcycles are permitted with the proper motorcycle credential that is available at your campground check-in booth.
- Other prohibited items include fireworks, illegal drugs, weapons of any description, glass containers, drones/aircraft of any kind, and other items that may pose a safety hazard or diminish the enjoyment of an event by other patrons

- Vehicles and other camping belongings must remain and fit in your allotted site.
- Please place trash in appropriate receptacles and/or trash bags.
- > Trash pick up times vary. Please keep trash can accessible so that it can be emptied.
- BMS is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property.
- Solicitation of any type is not permitted on BMS property. Sale of food, beverages, souvenirs or merchandise of any kind is not permitted.
- External stereo or television speakers are permitted, provided the noise does not disturb other patrons. DJs or live bands are not permitted.

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS



- Generators are NOT permitted in hookup camping sections
- PLEASE BE AWARE OF CARBON MONOXIDE DANGERS.
 Carbon monoxide is a poisonous gas that you cannot see or smell, but fumes can be harmful or fatal.
- Generators are permitted in Bronze Non-Hookup section.

- If exhaust/noise levels exceed a respectful level you will be asked to turn them off.
- Extensions are recommended on all generators.
- Violation of these rules may result in you being required to turn off/reposition generator or possibly move to a new location.



CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS



SHOWER HOUSE

A shower facility is available for your use and is located across from Nitro Alley. For access to the shower facility from Gold, Silver & Bronze please use Tunnel 2 or contact the check-in booth for assistance. For access to the shower facility from Medallion Campground please use the ramp that leads directly to the shower house, or call the Medallion Campground booth for a shuttle. The hours of operation are as follows

PETS

You are allowed to bring your family pet(s) when visiting the campgrounds at BMS, however pets are not permitted in the grandstand areas during race events, unless the animal is a service animal. To ensure safety and enjoyment of all guests and campers please abide by these policies:

- Please keep your pets leashed at all times when outside of your camper.
- ➤ If a dog is aggressive or causes disturbances you will be asked to kennel the dog.
- All dogs must be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times.
- Please clean up after your pet and properly dispose of the waste.
- ➤ Please do not walk your pet through another camper's site or allow them to relieve themselves on someone else's site.



SERVICES, PARKING, SAFETY & TRANSPORTATION



SAFETY

For pedestrian safety and traffic patterns, post-race traffic will be prevented from exit from ALL of the camping areas until it is clear. Once that determination has been made, BMS personnel will allow campers/RVs/vehicles to exit. Please be advised that anyone who does not abide by rules could jeopardize future renewal privileges.

POST EVENT TRAFFIC EXIT

During post event traffic exit (Friday/Saturday/Sunday) vehicles will be unable to enter the property until traffic is clear (Approximately 1 hour). Please plan accordingly when leaving and returning to the camping areas.

ADA ASSISTANCE

If you need ADA assistance please notify your campground check-in booth. ADA shuttles are available at all Guest Services locations.

MEDALLION CAMPGROUND SHUTTLE

The Medallion golf cart shuttles will PICK-UP at the top of the ramp in Medallion and DROP-OFF at designated gate locations. Golf carts will also PICK-UP at the shower house to bring you back up to Medallion Campground.

CAMPGROUND TRAM SERVICE

A tram will be running in Gold, Silver & Bronze camping on race days that will pickup at shuttle stops in Silver & Bronze.

 (One service per day included; and must fit within the perimeters of your campsite)
