



2026 NASCAR Garage and Pit Pass Overview + FAQ

How long does it take to receive my NASCAR VIP Pass invite? Your electronic invite will be generated and sent as soon as your information has been entered into the system. If you feel like your invite has been delayed, or if you have not received it by Wednesday, September 16th, of race week, please contact Teresa Vesey at Teresav@speedwaymotorsports.com

How do I complete my registration? All guests will receive an electronic invite via email or text message. Completing the registration process works best when using a smart phone. Email invites will come from invite@nascar.com* with a link to access NASCAR Garage & Pit Road Pass registration forms. Text invites will come from a phone number with a (386) area code and will contain a link to complete the registration process. **Email invites may be sent to Junk or SPAM folders, so be sure to check your SPAM.*

What should I do if my name is spelled incorrectly on my NASCAR Garage & Pit Road Pass registration form? If you notice a misspelling in either your first or last name, please do **NOT** complete the registration form. Contact Teresa Vesey and request the information be updated. Once updated, your invite will be resent with corrected details.

When and where can I pick up my NASCAR Garage & Pit Road Pass? Pick up your NASCAR Garage and Pit Road Pass at **Gate 9 Ticket Booth**. Located outside of Turn 3 in Lot B; because your NASCAR Garage and Pit Road pass is valid the entire race weekend, the Gate 9 ticket booth will be open each day; Please see times below

- Thursday 9/17 - Opens @ 9 AM
- Friday 9/18- Opens @ 11 AM
- Saturday 9/19 - Opens @ 4:30 PM

What access do I get with my NASCAR Garage & Pit Road Pass? This pass gives you access to the NASCAR Cup, O'Reilly Auto Parts and Truck Series garages, as well as pit road during Bass Pro Shops Night Race Weekend;

Are minors able to receive a NASCAR VIP Pass? NO. Minors are prohibited in the Garage Area at BMS

Do I need to wear closed-toe shoes and long pants in the garage and pit road areas? No. While it is HIGHLY recommended to wear closed-toe shoes in the garage and pit areas, they are not mandatory. Long pants are also not required while in these areas.

Early Parking Lot Access

Ultimate Fan Pass (UFP) guests who plan to arrive **before the parking lots officially open** must show the following to the parking attendant for early access:

- Digital Ultimate Fan Pass in the app or mobile wallet

- Pre-purchased parking pass
